



OUR FUTURE AS TOLD BY WATER: RESTORING OUR RIVERS TO SUSTAIN LIFE ON EARTH

There are more than 50,000 large dams on the planet, and more on the way. Nearly 400 dams are planned or being built in Central America, 1,700 in Brazil, and more than 200 in China's Yangtze River basin alone. Providing critically needed power and water to communities, these structures also block the fluid highways used by migrating fish and rearrange the flow rhythms that have choreographed aquatic life for eons.

Can rivers today be managed to sustain their diversity of life? That's the question Brian Richter circles the globe to answer. For over 20 years he's studied river management and restoration, consulting on more than 120 river projects and helping governments, industry, nonprofits and communities create solutions. He offers hope that we can meet one of the most pressing conservation challenges of our time.

An avid fly-fishing Kansan, Jim Ratzlaff brought his lifelong passion for rivers and prairies with him to Oregon's Umpqua Valley when he retired from business to pursue a life of active conservation — as a volunteer leader of several conservation organizations, as owner of a sustainably managed ranch, and as a dedicated supporter of efforts to protect river and grassland habitats in Oregon and beyond, including a significant expansion of Zumwalt Prairie Preserve.


